Few See Signs of Slowdown Amid the Market's Growth

The construction market is cyclical. Executives at large U.S. contractors understand this and also understand that the current booming market will not last forever. However, despite the fact that this is one of the longest domestic upswings on record, few see signs that it will abate any time soon. So they are working hard now to take advantage of the opportunities available without losing sight of what the future may bring.

The domestic market was one of strong, steady growth for large contrac-

tors. This can be seen from the results of the ENR Top 400 Contractors survey. The Top 400, as a group, generated a record \$373.98 billion in contracting revenue in 2017, an increase of 2.1% from 2016's \$366.41 billion. However, the real story is on the domestic side.

Contracting revenue from U.S. projects rose a healthy 4.9%, to \$322.83 billion, on top of a 9.4% rise in domestic revenue last year and a 9.5% increase the year before. On the other hand, contracting revenue from projects outside the

U.S. plunged 18.4%, to \$35.55 billion, in 2017, with major declines noted in projects in the mining-and-metals and petroleum sectors and a falloff in the general building sector abroad.

Many contractors did not believe the market could continue to grow as long as it has, and few see any signs that this growth will taper off. "Two years ago, I said we were in the late innings of the construction boom. I am really glad I was wrong," says Dan McQuade, group president for construction at AECOM.

McQuade concedes that this is a cyclical industry and that he has been through three major market recessions. "But right now, we're bullish. We have our sights on \$14 billion to \$15 billion in projects coming up, and that could grow to as much as \$20 billion if the economy holds up."

Many firms are using the steady growth in the market to focus on what they do best, rather than scrambling for any opportunities that come along. "We project the markets we serve will continue to grow in the next several years, so our strategic plan does not include any new markets," says Larry Rooney, president of Manhattan Construction Group. However, he says the firm is increasing the scope of services it offers in its current markets.

Turner Construction is another firm that is maintaining its focus on its primary markets. Pat A. Di Filippo, executive vice president, says Turner's big markets, like health care, commercial, education and convention centers, are all busy. "We want to make sure first of all that we saturate those markets. We will not take people out of those sectors to chase work in other sectors," he says. ■

How To Read the Tables

Companies are ranked by construction revenue in 2017 in (\$) millions. Those with subsidiaries (†) are listed by company rank, which may be found on the ENR website at www.enr.com. Firms not ranked last year are designated as **. Some markets may not add up to 100% due to omission of the "other" miscellaneous market category. NA = "not available."

Figures include prime construction contracts, shares of joint ventures, subcontracts, the construction portion of design-construct contracts and construction management-at-risk contracts when the firm's risks are similar to those of a general contractor. Figures also include the value of installed equipment when a firm has prime responsibility for specifying and procuring it within

the scope of its construction contract.

General Building includes commercial buildings, offices, stores, educational facilities, government buildings, hospitals, medical facilities, hotels, apartments, housing, etc.

Manufacturing includes auto assembly, electronic assembly, textile plants, etc.

Power includes thermal and hydroelectric power plants, waste-to-energy plants, transmission lines, substations, cogeneration plants, etc.

Water Supply includes dams, reservoirs, transmission pipelines, distribution mains, irrigation canals, desalination and potability treatment plants, pumping stations, etc.

Sewerage-Solid Waste includes sanitary and storm

sewers, treatment plants, pumping plants, incinerators, industrial waste facilities, etc.

Industrial Process includes pulp and paper mills, steel mills, non-ferrous metal refineries, pharmaceutical plants, chemical plants, food and other processing plants, etc.

Petroleum includes refineries, petrochemical plants, offshore facilities, pipelines, etc.

Transportation includes airports, bridges, roads, canals, locks, dredging, marine facilities, piers, railroads, tunnels, etc.

Hazardous Waste includes chemical and nuclear waste treatment, asbestos and lead abatement, etc.

Telecommunications includes transmission lines and cabling, towers and antennae, data centers and web hotels, etc.

Seattle Expansion

Work begins on one of the largest projects in local history

Clark Construction Group and Lease Crutcher Lewis have teamed up as a joint venture, Clark | Lewis, to build the \$960-million Washington State Convention Center in downtown Seattle. An official groundbreaking was held Aug. 14. The project, designed by LMN Architects, has taken nearly 10 years to design and plan, along with another two years of preconstruction. This 1.4-million-sq-ft addition, called Summit, is one of the largest projects in downtown Seattle history. Once completed, Summit will nearly double the convention center's exhibition space. Construction includes a ballroom and flex space with an outdoor terrace and exhibit hall, along with two adjacent building podiums to house future residential and commercial development in the area. The project team began demolition of selected surrounding structures in late July. The Clark | Lewis team has established a goal to award \$80 million in contracts to local MBE and WBE businesses. Work is expected to be completed within 36 months. ■

Turner Construction FC Cincinnati Stadium

Construction is expected to start later this year on the \$200-million FC Cincinnati Stadium, home to the newest Major League Soccer franchise. Turner was selected as construction manager for the 21,000-seat stadium in July.

Balfour Beatty Capitol Crossing

The North Block phase of Property Group Partners' Capitol Crossing development spans a three-block elevated deck in Washington, D.C. The 2.2-million-sq-ft mixed-use development will reunite the District's East End and Capitol Hill neighborhoods. Construction includes two 12-story, mixed-use office buildings that will be linked through a glass connector bridge and will total 960,000 sq ft. Capitol Crossing is designed to exceed LEED Platinum criteria, making it the first eco-district in the nation's capital. Work will end in Q4 2019.

Skanska Capitol Tower

Upon completion in 2019, Capitol Tower will be the most sustainable office tower in Houston, using 25% less energy than typical baseline facilities. One of only four core-and-shell projects to be pre-certified under LEED v4 Platinum nationwide, the 780,000-sq-ft sustainable office development will feature green amenities such as the 24,000-sq-ft Sky-Park, the first and largest green roof in Downtown Houston to be open to all building tenants. The street and tunnel levels will come together at the base of the tower with Understory, an expansive two-story destination that will feature over 35,000 sq ft of community and retail space.

Located on the Brooklyn waterfront, Building 72 is a 600,000-sq-ft, 16-story steel structure situated between two decommissioned dry docks in a FEMA flood zone. Gilbane's alternative foundation design approach resulted in significant cost savings and minimized the challenges of building a steel structure on a pier. Work will wrap up this fall.

**Skanska and Traylor Bros.
Connecting L.A. Systems**

A \$1.4-billion, 1.9-mile underground light-rail system with three new stations will provide direct connections between existing systems in Los Angeles. A 22-ft-dia, 1,000-ton, 350-ft-long tunnel-boring machine excavated approximately 130,000 cu yd for the project, which is slated for completion in 2022. Skanska and Traylor Bros. lead the joint venture constructing the project.

**Skanska and Walsh
Rebuilding an Airport**

The \$4-billion rebuilding of LaGuardia International Airport's central terminal, the nation's largest public-private partnership of its kind, includes a new 1.3-million-sq-ft terminal with an 840,000-sq-ft headhouse, two island concourses, 35 flight gates and concessions. Each concourse will connect to the headhouse via pedestrian bridges that are 370 ft long, with clearance of at least 56 ft to span over planes taxiing below. Skanska and Walsh lead the design-build team for the concessionaire.

**Kiewit
Widening Las Vegas Artery**

The nearly \$1-billion, 3.7-mile-long widening of Interstate 15 in downtown Las Vegas, dubbed Project Neon, is the state of Nevada's largest and most expensive public works project. Kiewit Infrastructure West Co., the general contractor under a \$559.4-million design-build contract, completed a 2,606-ft-long, 81-ft-tall flyover last year. Project Neon will improve the busiest stretch of highway in Nevada. Traffic through the corridor is expected to double by 2035 from the current 300,000 vehicles a day. The upgrade will connect carpool lanes on U.S. Highway 95 to the Interstate 15 express lanes with that signature flyover bridge. The project will also create direct-access carpool ramps and a new interchange called Neon Gateway, reconstruct the Charleston Boulevard interchange and extend Grand Central Parkway over the Union Pacific Railroad tracks. The project also converts two existing I-15 express lanes into a general purpose and HOV lane, creating 22 consecutive miles of carpool lanes between I-15 and U.S. 95.

High-Speed Rail Plows On

First construction contract progresses in Central Valley

About \$3 billion and 119 miles of track construction is underway or under contract on California's planned high-speed rail, which, ultimately, is proposed to stretch between Sacramento and San Diego. Construction Package 1, the first major construction contract for the first phase of the California High-Speed Rail Program, is a 32-mile stretch between Madera County and Fresno County. It includes 12 grade separations, two viaducts, one trench and a major river crossing over the San Joaquin River. Precast, prestressed concrete girders used for the project are up to 198 ft long. The design-build team of Tutor-Perini/Zachry/Parsons is approximately 55% complete with its \$1-billion contract, says Steven Milton, design and construction manager for the California High-Speed Rail Authority. A significant feature of the alignment will be a concrete staggered-arch structure that will rise over the San Joaquin River and State Route 99. Major challenges include extensive utility relocations, working alongside an active freight railroad and completing rights-of-way acquisitions. Completion of CP1 is currently slated for 2019. ■

Bechtel

South Field Energy

Bechtel was selected in September to design and build a combined-cycle plant in Columbiana County, Ohio, that will be owned by a group of investors including an affiliate of Bechtel Development Co. The \$1.3-billion facility, known as South Field Energy, will produce 1,182 MW of power when completed in 2021. The facility is the second major project in Ohio for the Bechtel-Advanced Power team, which finished the Carroll County Energy Facility in 2017. The team is also building the Cricket Valley Energy Center in Dover, N.Y.

Mortenson

MidAmerican Wind Farms

MidAmerican Energy has selected Mortenson to build two wind farms, Arbor Hill and Ivester, totaling 341 MW, in Iowa as part of MidAmerican's Wind XI plan to install 2,000 MW of wind in the state by 2019. Arbor Hill will include 125 Vestas turbines with tower hub heights of 95 meters, totaling 250 MW of output. The Ivester project will consist of 35 Siemens Gamesa turbines with tower heights of 85.1 m and 80 m totaling 91 MW. Mortenson will self-perform all civil and high voltage work for the projects.

Zachry

Okeechobee Gas Plant

Zachry Group is finishing work on a \$750-million combined-cycle plant in Okeechobee County, Fla., near Vero Beach it is building for Florida Power & Light. In August, the company reported that work was almost 75% complete. Much of the work remaining will be in the start-up and testing phase. The facility is Zachry's fourth EPC project for FPL.

Solar Rises in Popularity

Black & Veatch Continues Building Solar Farms for FPL

Solar power is continuing its growth spurt as a favored power-generation source, second only to natural gas in the first half of 2018. According to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 2,386 MW of solar was installed through July at 243 different sites in the U.S. In the same time period, 53 new natural gas-fired units were installed, accounting for 10,000 MW of the 14,735-MW total generation brought online in the first half of the year. According to the Solar Energy Industries Association (SEIA), California led installations in the first quarter of 2018, followed by Florida. Growth in the latter's solar is being driven by Florida Power

& Light, which has built or is building 14 solar plants in the state. FPL also announced earlier this year it will build four more plants by mid-2019. Black & Veatch is serving as the EPC contractor on multiple sites, including four projects currently in construction. The company has already built seven sites for FPL. SEIA says that in the short term, the industry is protected from new photovoltaic tariffs because some supply was acquired before the tariffs were put in place. But in the longer term, the association says the impacts will be significant, and several developers have already canceled projects. ■

Reversing the Flow

Companies Building LNG Plants to Meet Export Demand

The growing international demand for natural gas, coupled with the fracking boom in the U.S., has resulted in a steady increase in U.S. gas exports. McDermott is building export facilities at two existing LNG import terminals in the Southeast. McDermott and its joint venture partner, Chiyoda, were awarded a contract valued at approximately \$6 billion by Cameron LNG to build three export liquefaction trains in Hackberry, La. Upon completion, Cameron will produce at least 14.95 million tons of LNG per year. McDermott, along with its partners Zachry and Chiyoda, is performing engineering, procurement and construction of three additional LNG liquefaction trains at the existing Freeport LNG complex on Quintana Island near Freeport, Texas. McDermott is also building a double-walled, 165,000-cu-meter LNG storage tank at the site. Freeport LNG expects to begin construction of a fourth train by the end of the year. ■

Natural gas demand and LNG growth have historically been driven by power generation, which continues to be the main consumer. "However, industry has recently surpassed power generation as the largest driver for this demand growth, with renewables satisfying a significant portion of the power demand growth last year," says Don Hill, Global Vice President, McDermott, which is building LNG facilities at Freeport LNG (left). "Natural gas and LNG demand are in a very favorable position to continue growth in both the industrial sectors as well as working hand-in-hand with renewables to meet the global power demands."

Bechtel Port Arthur LNG

Sempra LNG and Port Arthur LNG, LLC, have selected Bechtel as the EPC contractor for their Port Arthur liquefaction project in Jefferson County, Texas. It will feature two liquefaction trains and produce 11 million tons of LNG annually. The project will also include feed gas pretreatment facilities, natural gas liquids and refrigerant storage, up to three LNG storage tanks, and two marine berths and associated facilities. Bechtel will perform the engineering, execution planning and related activities necessary to prepare and finalize a lump-sum EPC contract for the project.

TRC Companies Inc. Midship Pipeline

Midship Pipeline LLC has awarded TRC an EPC contract for three compressor stations, as well as an environmental consulting, engineering and field services contract. The 200-mile-long, 36-in-dia pipeline will convey 1.44 billion cu ft of natural gas per day from Kingfisher, Okla., to Bryan County, Okla. Sunland Construction will serve as construction contractor on the compressor stations. The project, which recently received its certificate order from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, is scheduled to be in service next year.

Formoso Petrochemical Sunshine Project

Formosa's subsidiary FG LA LLC is planning to construct a \$9.4-billion chemical manufacturing complex on a 2,400-acre site in St. James Parish, La. It will be carried out in two phases and produce ethylene, propylene, ethylene glycol and associated polymers. Construction could begin in 2019 and take up to a decade. The construction workforce is expected to peak at 8,000.

PC Construction
Maryland Resource
Recovery Plant

The team of PC Construction, Stantec and Hazen and Sawyer was selected in August to design and build the first phase of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission's \$250-million Piscataway Water Resource Recovery Facility Bio-Energy project in Prince George's County, Md., which will increase production of biogas to power the facility and boost the community supply. The utility says the project is the largest and most technically advanced in its 100-year history and will be among the first in the U.S. to incorporate an advanced thermal hydrolysis process to treat sewage sludge. The entire project is set to operate by spring 2024.

Garney Holding Co.
Lee County, Fla., Water Plant

The \$75.4-million Green Meadows water treatment plant in Lee County, Fla., completed by Garney in August, will purify water from three different aquifers and is the first of its kind in southwest Florida to process brackish and fresh water with multiple treatment systems. While the project, located near Fort Myers, is the county's second most expensive, it replaces a 40-year-old facility and will cut treatment cost per thousand gallons by 60%, officials say. The plant, which will process 14 million gallons per day from the Atlantic Ocean, Gulf of Mexico and other sources, is the key water supplier for county utilities.

Fluor Corp.
Ohio Nuclear Cleanup Site

At the former Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant in Piketon, Ohio, a one-time U.S. Dept. of Energy uranium enrichment processing site, officials have ramped up use this year of autonomous robots developed by Carnegie Mellon University to identify uranium deposits on pipe walls. The cleanup is being managed by Fluor and BWXT. Robots can measure radiation more accurately from inside the pipe than is possible with external techniques. The Portsmouth site has 10.6 million sq ft of floor space, making it DOE's largest enclosed facility, and more than 75 miles of process pipe. Fluor, BWXT and CH2M also won last year a \$1.5-billion contract for cleanup of a similar facility in Paducah, Ky.

Loan Boosts Biosolids Plant

Big San Francisco project is set to move forward in 2019

San Francisco's Southeast wastewater treatment plant, the city's largest and oldest such facility, handling up to 250 mgd in peak periods, will receive a major upgrade with an innovative biosolids digester unit to replace one more than 60 years old. The estimated \$1.4-billion project will be built by a joint venture of Webcor Builders and MWH Constructors, a unit of Stantec, which was selected last year. The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission project last month gained a \$699-million low-interest loan from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency under the federal Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act program, the agency's largest such loan to date. The more earthquake-resilient plant, which will generate reusable biosolids and biogas, also will maximize energy and water recovery and be sited farther from residences. Flatiron Construction and Dragados North America also competed for the project. Leading the project design team is Brown and Caldwell. Construction of the facility, in the city's Bayview-Hunters Point section, is set to begin in early 2019 with facilities operating by 2025. ■

The Arauco Particleboard Plant in Grayling, Mich., being built by Barton Marlow required more than 15,000 cu yd of cast-in-place concrete for the 820,000-sq-ft, \$400-million project. 3D and 4D models gave the team a visual planning system that incorporated timing and scheduling. Crews used a material unit lift enhancer, a lift-assist robot from Construction Robotics that lets workers lift heavy blocks. Primary construction was completed on May 31, while add-on work continues. Amec Foster Wheeler was joint partner with Arauco in plant engineering for the project.

Kentucky Aluminum Mill
Kiewit building 300,000-ton-per-year greenfield plant

On June 1, officials celebrated the groundbreaking of Braidy Atlas, a \$1.6-billion, 2.5-million-sq-ft greenfield aluminum mill located on 300 acres near Ashland, Ky. Owner Braidy Industries Inc. selected Kiewit as the EPC contractor for the project in mid-August. At the same time, the firm announced that SMS Group will be the project's equipment provider and EBNER Industrieofenbau GmbH Construction will provide the furnace. The project will be complete in 2020, and Braidy Industries is calling the facility the lowest-cost aluminum mill in the world. Braidy Atlas will be the first greenfield aluminum mill in North America in

years, according to Braidy Industries. It will also be one of the most technologically advanced rolling mills in the world and the first ever to be fully optimized from the ground up for automotive manufacturing, the company says. During construction, which is now underway, the project is expected to create an estimated 1,000 jobs. Upon completion, the company expects to employ more than 600 full-time staff. Officials expect the mill's production capacity to be about 300,000 tons of aluminium alloy sheet and plate per year, primarily serving the automotive industry. ■

**Gray Construction
Paper Production Plant**

Construction has begun on The Sofidel Group's new greenfield integrated paper production plant in Inola, Okla. The firm is investing \$360 million over three years in the facility. Gray is design-build contractor on the project, which is expected to be complete by 2020.

**Clayco
Tire Manufacturing**

Clayco is the design-build contractor on the manufacturing portion of the \$360-million Nokian Tyres tire manufacturing facility in Rhea County, Tenn. Production is scheduled to start in 2020. The new facility will be capable of manufacturing 4 million tires annually. This is Nokian Tyres' first North American manufacturing facility.

**Hensel Phelps
Satellite Manufacturing**

The 266,000-sq-ft Gateway Center is a design-build project for the assembly, integration and test of national security, scientific and commercial satellites for Lockheed Martin Space Systems in Denver. Hensel Phelps will serve as the general contractor for the project that includes a Class 100k clean room capable of holding five modernized satellites or multiple small- to medium-sized satellites at one time. Other aspects of the project include an anechoic chamber that is built for large, high-powered communication satellite testing, while the thermal vacuum chamber simulates the harsh environments of space to allow comprehensive testing on full-assembled satellites. Construction began in June 2017 and completion is scheduled for February 2020.
